With your child:

- We welcome phone calls and questions from other parents

With other youth:

- We do not allow possession, serving or use of alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs in our home or on our property
- We welcome phone calls from parents in the community
- We have the same expectations as other families participating in the Parents Supporting Parents Network

GOAL

To develop a network of parents and other adults working together to implement the **Parents Supporting Parents (PSP) Network** in their homes, schools and community.



OBJECTIVES

Parents and guardians will supervise all gatherings of youth in their homes

Families will not knowingly allow the possession or use of alcohol or other drugs by youth in their homes

Members of the PSP Network will feel free to communicate with each other, support one another, and welcome phone calls from other parents

THE PLEDGE

- 1.** I will actively supervise all gatherings of youth in our home or on our property, or ask another responsible adult for help to do so.
- 2.** I will not allow the possession or use of alcohol, tobacco or other drugs by youth in our home or on our property.
- 3.** I will set expectations for my children by knowing where they are, whom they are with, what they are doing and when they are to return home.

This pledge is NOT a legally binding contract, but rather an agreement between the participants in the PSP Network.
